DISA Board of Directors nominations will be accepted through March 19, 2010 and the selected slate will be balloted amongst ASC X12 members in March-April 2010. The new Board members' term will begin in the Summer of 2010.

Nomination applications must include the following:

- Nominator contact information, including Title, Company, Business Address, Phone, e-mail
- Candidate contact information
- Details of the candidate's professional career, including e-business-related experience
- 100-200 word statement of the candidate's qualifications and interest in serving on the DISA Board of Directors
- Acknowledgement of employer support to attend Board meetings, including financial obligations regarding travel
- Nominator statement supporting the candidate's accomplishments
